Adarsh Ramanujan is a Director in the Geneva Office of Lakshmikumaran & Sridharan, primarily focusing on two practice areas – IP laws and international trade law. He holds a Master's degree from the University of California, Berkeley, specializing in IPR, antitrust and drug regulatory laws. He is admitted to practice law in India and in the State of California, USA. Adarsh started his practice in the area of IP and related regulatory laws, focusing mostly on contentious proceedings before Indian patent office, the Intellectual Property Appellate Board and Civil courts. In his IP practice, he is involved with issues relating to standards, open source licensing, food safety standards, drug regulatory laws and competition law. His practice area extends to the fields of Energy, Chemistry, Pharmaceuticals, Biotechnology and Hi-tech industry segments. He advises companies on strategic IP portfolio management in India.

More recently, he is also actively involved in the International Trade law wing of Lakshmi Kumaran & Sridharan, advising governments and multinational corporations on international economic laws and international dispute settlements. Particularly, his international trade law practice focuses on international trade disputes covering trade remedies, sanitary and phyto-sanitary measures, technical regulations, TRIPS and standards.
