Sebastian Wündisch has practiced intellectual property law in Munich, New York and in the meantime at Noerr LLP's Dresden office for 17 years now. As member of Noerr's IP Group, he specializes in technology transfer, R&D related matters and employee invention law, and advises SMEs and publicly-listed technology firms as well as research institutions.

Sebastian studied law in Passau, Exeter (LL.M.) and Dresden and received his Ph.D. from the University of Leipzig in 2002 (copyright law). He acts as lecturer for intellectual property law at various universities and since 2010 has headed the Research Center on Technology Transfer at the Law Faculty of the Dresden University of Technology.

Sebastian is a well-recognized author in the field of intellectual property law and in 2012 he was appointed honorary professor for intellectual property law and technology transfer by the Dresden University of Technology.
