Annual general meeting was held on April 25, 2019. The Estonian national group consists of people who have different professional backgrounds and are active in many fields and other organisations. Two members of the group are high officials of the Estonian PTO. One member is a professor emeritus of Business Law at the Tallinn University of Technology. One member is currently an in-house counsel and two members are currently under the age of 36. Two members are also members of the Estonian Domain Disputes Committee, which is a specific independent body for resolution of disputes pertaining to .ee domains. One member is an active member of the epi Finance Committee and epi Professional Education Committee.

On March 29, 2019 a meeting of the Chamber of Estonian Patent Attorneys was held. It is a compulsory professional association for patent and trademark attorneys practicing in Estonia. One member was elected as Vice-Chairman of the Chamber and additional two members of the Estonian national group as management board members of the Chamber.
