The annual general meeting of the Hungarian NG is always combined with a professional program. This year, all of the four study committees have presented their work on the study questions. The NG regularly submits comments to planned legislation. In 2019, the Hungarian NG filed a submission on the following topic: - Preliminary consultation on the implementation of (EU) 2019/790 and (EU) 2019/789 Directives. The NG organises a Christmas party every December along with five other national IP organisations, with a very good turnout. A reduced national fee has been decided for young and senior members.
